remain in full force. This bond is not conditioned on nonconstruction services or payment to persons furnishing such services.

This bond is meant to comply with all the requirements of Section 255.05, Florida Statutes, and herewith incorporates all duties of a surety required by Section 255.05, Florida Statutes, and all notice and time limitation provisions set forth in Sections 255.05(2) and 255.05 (10), Florida Statutes. The Surety, for value received, hereby stipulates and agrees that no change, extension of time, alteration or addition to the terms of the Contract or to the work to be performed thereunder or to the specifications accompanying the same shall in any way affect its obligations on this bond, and it does hereby waive notice of any such change, extension of time, alteration or addition to the terms of the Contract or to the work or to the specifications.
